



TYPES OF HEARING TESTS

Tests can be done to know the level and type of hearing loss. These test are not painful and some are done while the child is asleep.

THESE TESTS ARE:

Auditory Brainstem Response (ABR)

This test is used to identify the child's level of hearing.

Otoacoustic Emission (OAE)

This test checks if the Cochlea (inner ear) is working.

Acoustic Immittance (Middle Ear Analysis)

These are a series of tests used to measure the ability of the middle ear to conduct sound and to identify problems occurring in the middle ear

Pure Tone Testing

These are a series of tests used to identify the softest sounds the child can hear and the type of loss that is present.
